FOX BAITING

Autumn 2018



Help reduce the fox population in
the district

Why bait now?

- Baiting twice a year effectively reduces fox numbers.
- Autumn baiting targets young foxes seeking new territory.
- Baiting prior to lambing increases lamb survival.
- Reduced fox population to target next spring
- Improves your income and sustainability of the environment.

Baits

- Fresh chicken wingettes poisoned with 1080- Minimum charge **\$10.00**
- Manufactured Foxoff baits

Using 1080 poison baits

1080 is a dangerous poison so there are some important facts you must be aware of:

1. **You MUST give any landholders within 1km of a bait site three days notification**, because 1080 will kill dogs.
2. We cannot supply baits unless you sign a declaration that you have notified your neighbours, and you hold a current chemical users card.
3. You **MUST** display 1080 warning signs on your property where baits are laid.
4. Baits **MUST** be kept secure, away from children, animals and foodstuffs while being transported and/or stored.

Order must include- your name, property name, contact number, chemical card number & exp date, bait type, number of baits & collection point

Remember 'no card, no baits'

Vertebrate Pest Induction Training (1080/Pindone) courses are offered by Murray Local Land Services . The course takes approximately three hrs and cost is only \$22.00. Accreditation lasts for five years. This will allow you to purchase 1080 baits and pindone.
