# Dung Beetle Workshop

You're invited to Holbrook Landcare's dung beetle workshop on the 18th of March.

Dung Beetle Ecosystem Engineers (DBEE) researcher, Dr Russ Barrow, will be on hand to discuss the project, including the process of monitoring the distribution, abundance and diversity of dung beetles in the area.

Holbrook Landcare has partnered with CSU's DBEE project in an effort to distribute a new species of dung beetle into the region with the aim of filling the identified spring gap. The *Onthophagus vacca* originates from Morocco and is active from late winter to mid summer.

This is an opportunity to hear the latest information on dung beetle species & populations, and see first hand which dung beetles are currently active in this region.
