What is iNaturalist:

An online social network platform for sharing biodiversity information to help each other learn about nature. The primary goal is to connect people to nature


- Connect with other users, see their pics and get help with IDs
- Use it for fun: become more proficient in identifications
- Learn what is important to capture in your photo; or in your visual notes to help with identification
- Have fun recording your finds; learn about nature and assist in creating useful data
- Connect with experts
- Become involved as a family- you are never too young or old to enjoy the marvels of your backyard.

-  **Keep Track**
Record your encounters with other organisms and maintain life lists, all in the cloud.
-  **Create Useful Data**
Help scientists and resource managers understand when and where organisms occur.
-  **Crowdsource Identifications**
Connect with experts who can identify the organisms you observe.
-  **Become a Citizen Scientist**
Find a project with a mission that interests you, or start your own.
-  **Learn About Nature**
Build your knowledge by talking with other naturalists and helping others.
-  **Run a Bioblitz**
Hold an event where people try to find as many species as possible.
